Tapes and CDs of our service are available after the service in Great Hall. The cost is \$4.00.

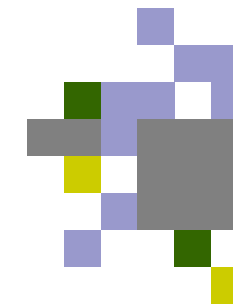
