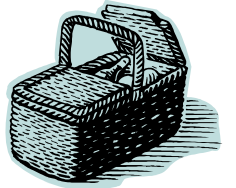
Flowers for our Worship today are in celebration of the 35th Wedding anniversary of Anthony and Peggy Sella, children of Shirley Washburn.
