## CHRISTIAN EDUCATION TODAY

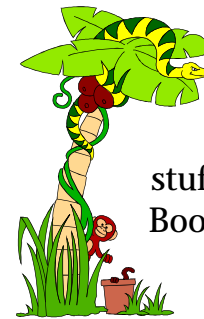

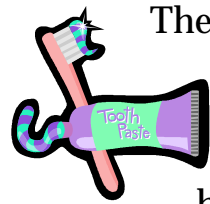
All Church Picnic - Sunday, Aug. 30<sup>th</sup>, 11:30 a.m.

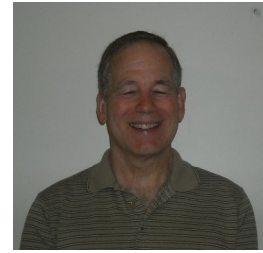
