Get your grocery cards for Safeway and King Soopers in Great Hall today and in the church office during the week. It is best to call before you come during the week to check on availability.

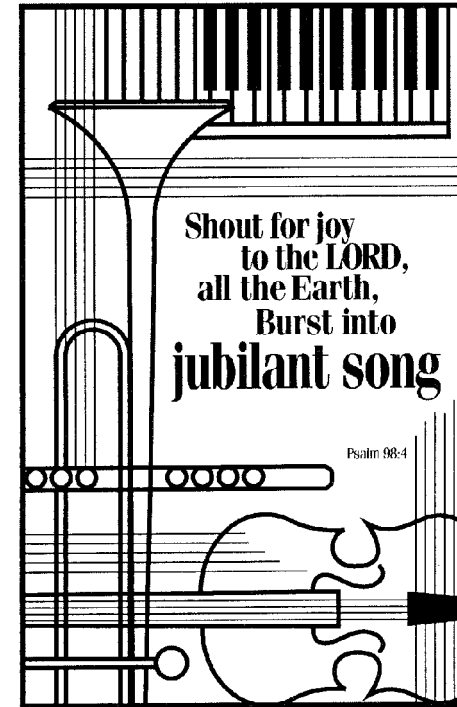
Plan now to bring a food item each time you come to church. The item for September for DenUM is cereal.

## United Methodist Women - Fall Tea September 26<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 p.m.

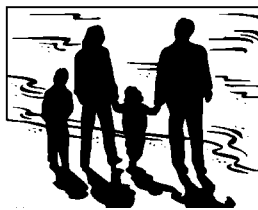
