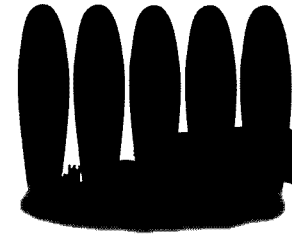
Please join us in Great Hall for fellowship and refreshments.
