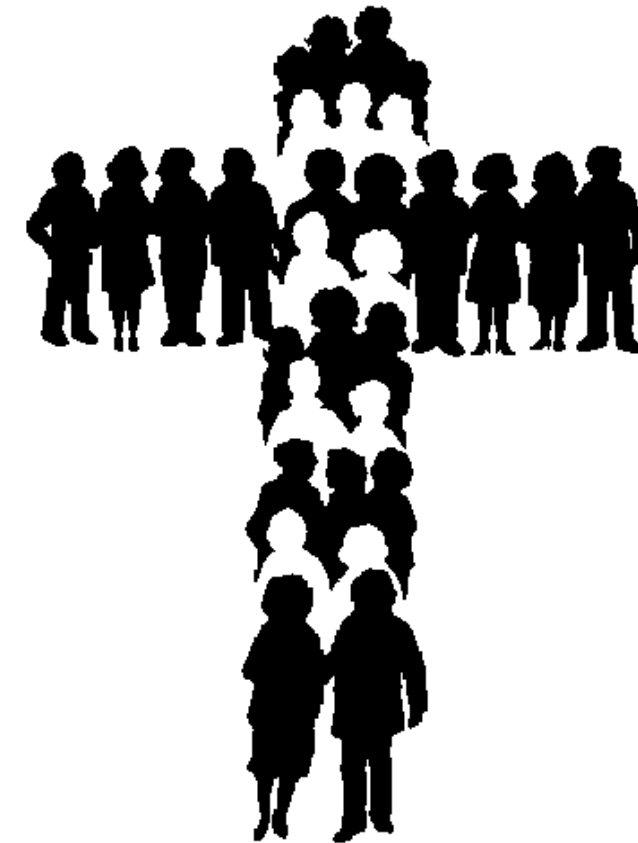

Flowers for our Worship today are given by Mike and Joni Smith for the enjoyment of the congregation.

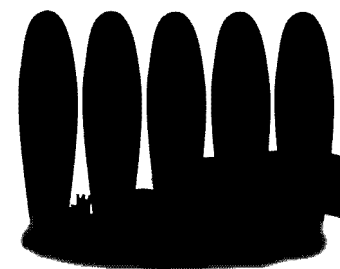
