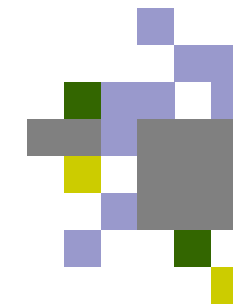
The item of the month of May for DenUM is rice. The Jeffco Action Center bin is in the hall for those donations.

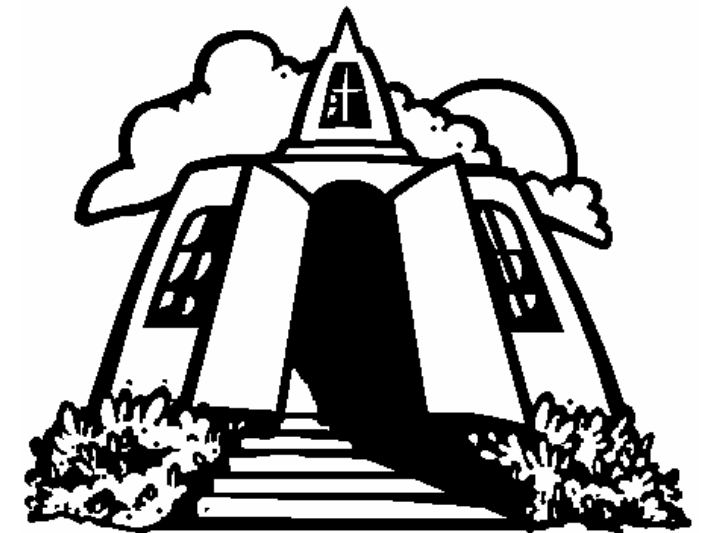
