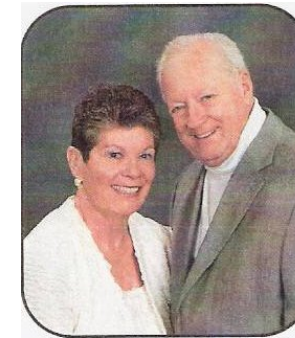

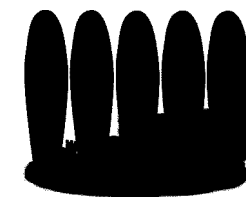
WE WELCOME NEW MEMBERS
