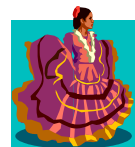
WELCOME VISITORS!

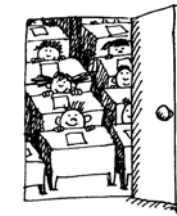

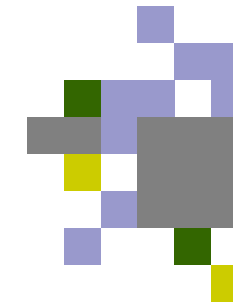
