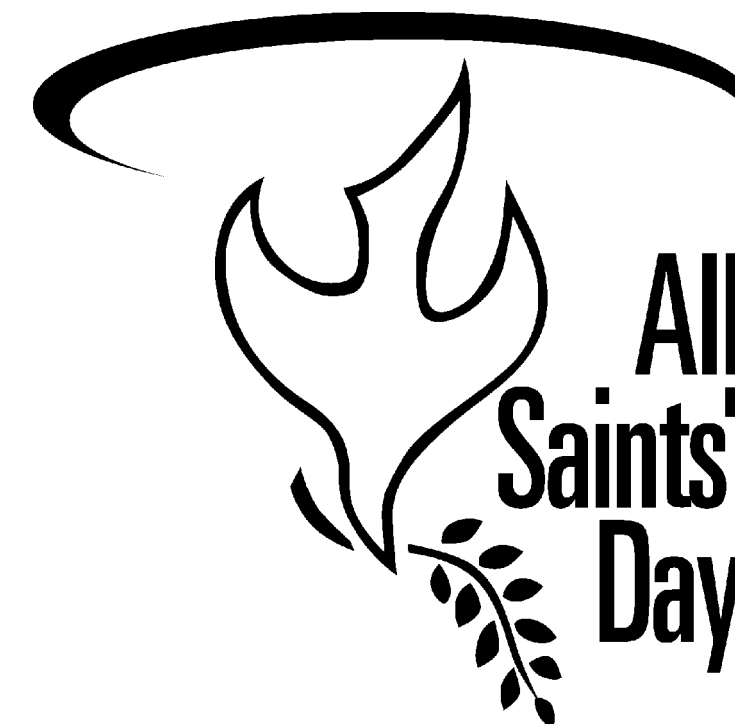
Winter is just around the corner and the Jeffco Action Center is in need of blankets for their clients. They will also accept your cash or check donations for blankets.
