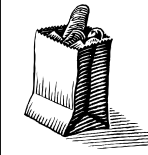

40 Tons for 40 Years!



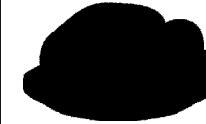

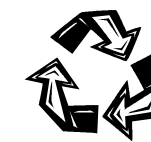
