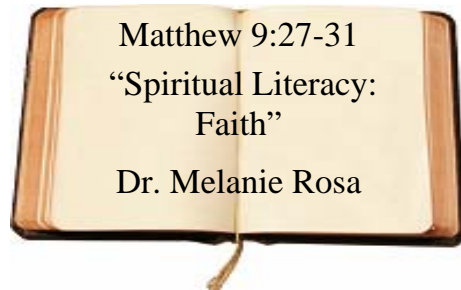

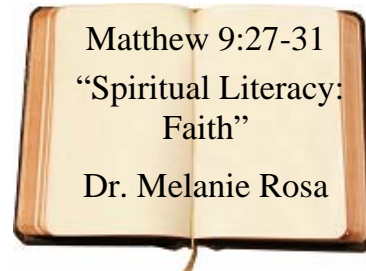

Be sure and get your grocery certificates/cards for Safeway and King Sooper before you do that grocery shopping. We receive 5% of all sales.

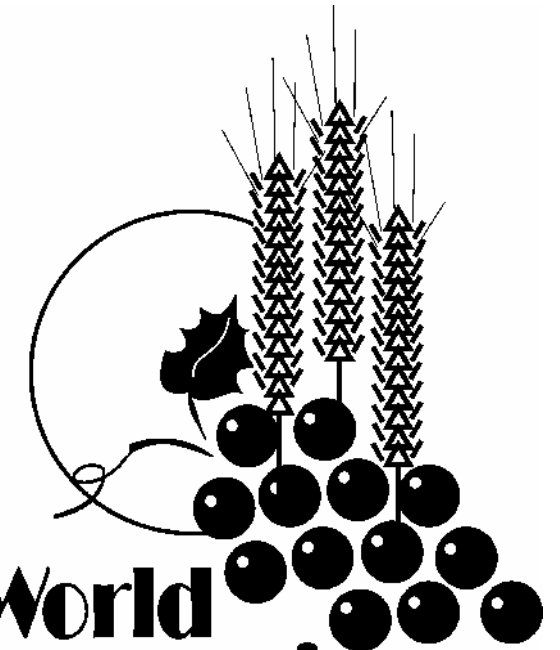
