Tapes/CDs of our service are available in the back of Great Hall following the service.

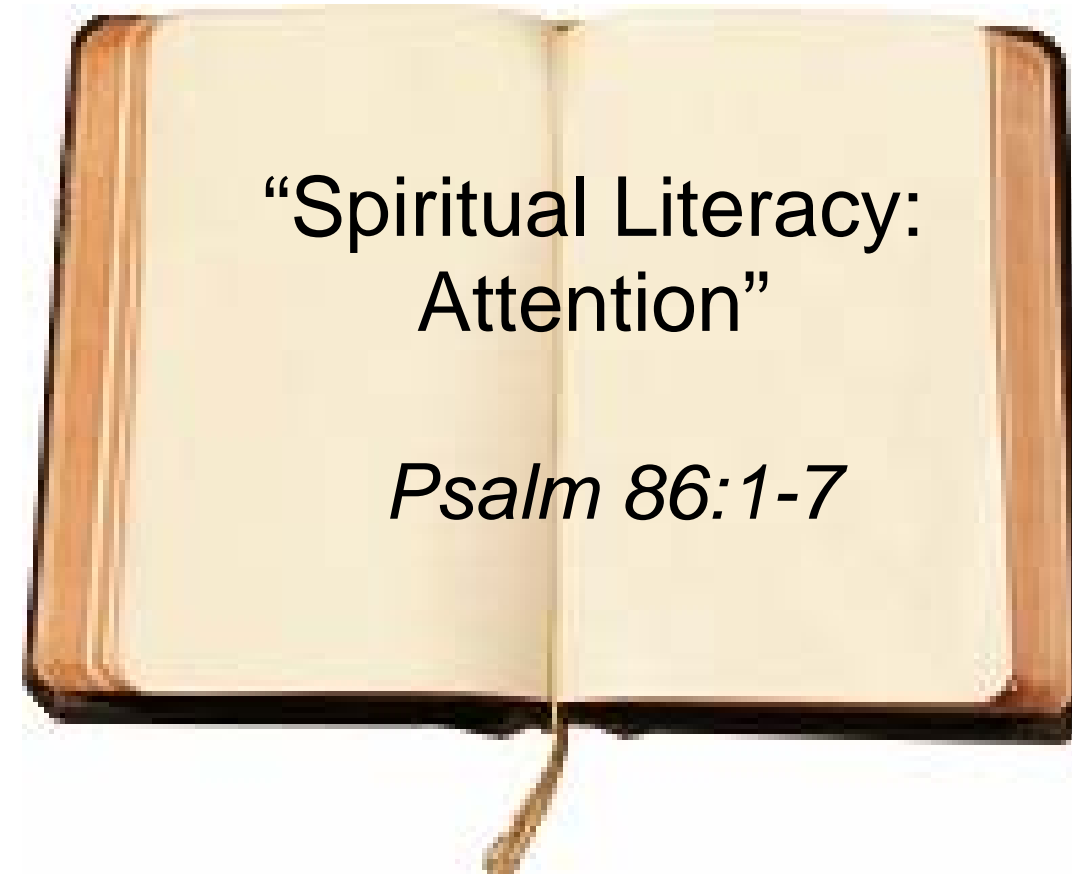

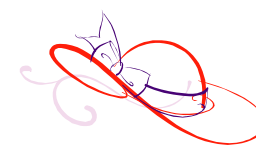
Sermon Series for September The ABCs of Spiritual Literacy
