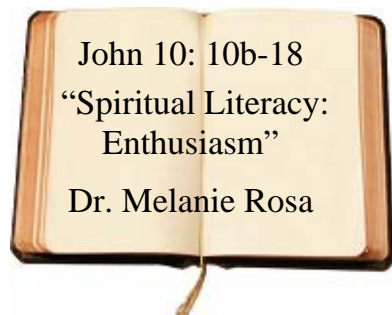


## Prayer Vigil Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>, 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
